1. Welcome & Roll Call
 - All members present
 - Previous meeting minutes approved with amended attendance (Ms. Ortiz was present)
2. Public Comment
 - Nicole Beer - Martinez librarian
 - i. She spoke on the positive incentives her presence has brought to the school.
 - ii. She feels unappreciated based on the rumors going around the school.
3. 2025-2026 Budget and SPO discussion and possible vote to approve the budget
 - Specialist five-schedule - The SLD-intermediate and two primary autism classes are not factored into the rotation.
 - i. Students must attend PE twice a week.
 - ii. \$126,000 will be freed up with a five-day rotation
 - iii. Principal perception - The open slots will be filled and accounted for. The slots will be used for coverage. Losing a specialist class will cause disruption and

movement of teachers/positions throughout the school. Recommends keeping the six-day specialist's rotation. Eliminating one CTT

- iReady - \$10,850 (half-off special deal)
 - i. Kindergarten through grade 5 curriculum
 - Is there a way support staff can get back up to 8 hours? - Ms. Herrera, Support Staff
 - When is the social student curriculum getting here? - Levesque
 - i. It is on campus. The curriculum is online and available to all teachers. Ms. Beer has been looking into it and trying to figure it out. - Mr. Adams
 - Discussion about where the allocations are from the different pots of funds given to the school.
 - i. The \$210,000 number is the amount left after allocating funds for staff and other items.
 - Discussion of supplies budget
 - i. About \$40,000 has been spent this year.
 - A vote is called for the approval of this budget. (1 to 7 - failed vote)
 - Ms. Herrera - Smarty Ants is gone for pre-kindergarten. She wondered what would be a replacement.
 - Discussion: How would the funds be used if we go to the five-day specialist rotation?
 - i. Adding and removing
 - ii. Keeping both CTTs and two paid preps
 - A vote is called for the approval of this budget. (3 to 5 a failed vote)
 - i. Why are you not okay with this? - Ms. Ortiz
 - 1. Ms. Herrera - "Because I will not get a full paycheck."
 - ii. What happened to why we are no longer on the same page? - Ms. Sierra
 - 1. People went home and digested the information. - Ms. Herrera
 - iii. Can we use the carryover funds to bring back the support staff hours? -Ms. Levesque
 - 1. What does accountability look like for giving support staff their time back? - Ms. Levesque
 - 2. Will it start now? - Ms. Levesque
 - a. Yes. - Mr. Adams
 - Vote - There will be no stipend in order to reinstate support hours, and the rest goes to teacher preps (8 to 0 carried vote)
 - Vote - All in favor of supporting this budget (8 to 0 carried vote)
